Apply 15 pounds per acre as soon as plants become established in field. Repeat at two week intervals, increasing treatment to 20 pounds per acre-In the time cop is half grown.

To not apply within 5 days of prime mag or 15 days of cutting. Avoid seaving plant pines coming into contact with the skin.

ANTIDOTE

If symptoms or signs of poisoning include blurred vision, abdominal cramps and tightness of chest don't wait for a doctor but give two atropine tablets (each 1/100 gr.) at once. Remove patient immediately from area where Parathion is present. Remove contaminated clothing and wash skin clean with plenty of soap and water, to remove all traces of Parathion. If swallowed, induce vomiting by giving warm salty or soapy water and repeat until comit fluid is clear. Do not give liquids to unconscious patient. Have patient lie down and keep quiet.
