Triangle 25% Chlordane Granules is a specially formulated product containing .25 pounds of Chlordane per pound of insecticide for control of various soil insects in lawns, nurseries, and certain crop lands.

The free-flowing and non-dusting properties make it especially adaptable for conventional

ground methods of application, as well as through seeding attachments and fertilizer granulars when mixed with fertilizer.

The granular nature enables this insecticide to sift through dense foliage, thus resulting in practically complete soil contact with minimum drift.

Directions For Use

For lawn and turf insects such as White Grubs and Japanese Beetle Larvae, apply 1 pound per 1,000 square feet of lawn. Wash the insecticide into the soil with ample quantities of water. Keep children and pets off treated areas until this material is washed into the soil and the grass is thoroughly dry.

For ants in lawns and ornamental turf apply 1 pound per 1,000 square feet, or for spot treatment, apply directly to individual ant hills and wash into the soil.

For mole crickets in lawns and around shrubbery, flowers, and other ornamentals, apply 12 pound per 1,000 square feet washing well into the soil.

For corn root worm in corn, apply broadcast at a rate of 16 pounds per acre. Apply on soil surface before planting. Work into top 3 inches of soil by disking or harrowing. For band treatment 6 inches wide per row, apply 4 to 6 pounds per acre.

For wire worms in potatoes: In sandy soils apply 8 pounds per acre. Clays or loams require 10 to 12 pounds per acre. Peats and mulchs require up to 40 pounds per acre. Apply before planting by broadcasting as for corn root worms.

For white fringed beetle control in small grains, corn, and peanuts, apply 4 to 12 pounds per

acre in drill rows, depending on spacing of rows, or 20 pounds per acre broadcast before planting. Work into the soil by disking or harrowing.

For Nursery soil apply this material to the soil at a rate of 10 to 20 pounds per acre as recommended by the proper authorities for certification of Plant Pest Control or State Quarantine Authorities.

Cautions

Chlordane is toxic and may be absorbed through the skin. Avoid inhaling spray and dusts. Avoid contamination of feedstuffs. Do not use on household pets, animals or humans. Do not use on dairy cattle or in dairy barns. Do not use in forage crops to be fed to dairy animals or those being finished for slaughter.

This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Birds feeding on treated areas may be harmed. Keep out of lakes, ponds, and streams. Do not apply to any area not specified on the label.

Harmful if swallowed. Wash thoroughly after use.

Antidote: Call a physician immediately. Internal: Emetic of mustard. External: Wash with soap and water.
