DIRECTIONS FOR USE IN COTTON

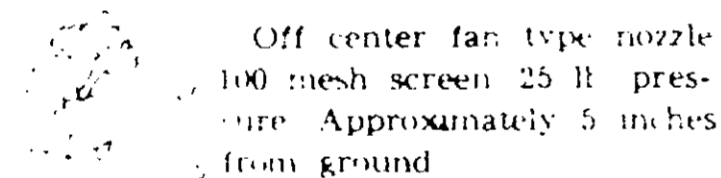
DIE-WEED is useful for the control of Johnson grass, goose grass, water grass, nut grass, and Dallas Grass. Always use Triangle D-W surfactant with DIE-WEED for best result.

RECOMMENDED RATES FOR USE IN COTTON. To treat one acre of cotton on the basis of a 40' row the following rates are recommended:

APPLY APPLICATION DIRECT ONLY ON WEEDS

Row Spacing	Amount of DIE-WEED (Liquid)	Amount of Triangle D-W Surfactant	Amount of Water
Hand Sprayed	1/2 Pint	1/2 Pint	12 Gallons
Machine Sprayed	1/2 Pint	1/2 Pint	14 Gallons

Apply as a post emergence DIRECTED spray on weeds when cotton is at least 5" high. Nozzles should be adjusted to direct the spray to weeds to obtain a maximum coverage of weeds with minimum contact of cotton. (See diagram)



This diagram is offered as a guide only in using DIE-WEED.

In new and insecticide practices can be applied. Apply DIE-WEED using diagram as guide.

Two applications may be made. Should regrowth occur, re-treat at the above rates 1 to 3 weeks after first application.

Do not apply after first bloom.

Clean equipment after use by flushing with water. Run rinse water away from domestic water sources.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GENERAL WEED AND GRASS CONTROL. DIE-WEED (Liquid) plus Triangle D-W surfactant has been found effective in controlling Johnson grass, goose grass, water grass, cocklebur, nutgrass and green and yellow foxtail along ditchbanks, right-of-ways, implement storage yards and ~~and~~ non-crop areas where cultivation is not practical.

RECOMMENDED RATES FOR GENERAL WEED CONTROL. To treat one acre, mix 2 pints of DIE-WEED (Liquid) with 28 gallons of water and 1 pint of D-W surfactant. Apply as a spray, thoroughly wetting foliage and stems of weeds to be killed. (For use in Cotton, see directions above)
