DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Cen-Pe-Co Face Fly Treatment may be op plied by hand or Dis-Pen-Sor.

Use a heavy cloth to wipe Cen-Pe-Co Face Fly Treatment on the faces of cattle, one (1) fluid ounce per animal. Pay particular attention to the area around the eyes, nostrils and pool behind the horns. Treatment should be made daily while the cattle are stanchioned for morning milking. This gives protection from face flies for 24 hours.

An easier way to protect large herds and cattle in pasture is through the use of one or more Cen-Pe-Co Dis-Pen-Sors.
