Dear Mr. Boaro:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable provided that you submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling with the following changes before you release the product for shipment:

1. Revise your precautionary statement to read as follows:

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals
CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Causes skin and respiratory tract irritation. Do not get on clothing. Avoid contact with skin. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

NOTICE: California has determined that a chemical contained in this product causes cancer based on tests performed on laboratory animals.

As you have decided to choose the toxicity category IV for eye irritation, please note that the above precautionary statement is the complete version required of all such products. The endnote statements in the format label provided to you with our January 28, 1999, letter were meant as substitutes to the above text if you were to choose a category III level wording for eye irritation.

Also make sure that the above "Notice" appears right below the precautionary statement, and not in a separate flap to your product's label.

This registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e) if you do not comply with these conditions. Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
