For control of bird lice on parakeets, canaries and other caged birds, leave birds in cage. Remove food and foodstuffs. Spray directly on birds from a distance of 12 to 18 inches. Avoid the bird's eyes and face, spray lightly utilizing 3 or 4 bursts.

For cage mite control, remove bird(s), food and water cups, etc., and spray cage thoroughly by holding unit at least one foot from surface utilizing 5 or 6 bursts. To control mites and bird lice, may repeat treatment on cage or bird no more than two times a week. Bird cages should be cleaned in hot water as part of weekly regimen.

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: If empty: Do not reuse container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.

FIRST AID
