SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE
 Remove animal from cage. Hold bottle upright and point nozzle opening in desired direction of spray. Spray the animal from a distance of 8-12 inches. Start spraying at the tail, moving the dispenser rapidly and making sure the animal's entire body is covered, including the legs and under body. While spraying, lift the hair so that spray will penetrate to the skin. Make sure spray wets thoroughly. Do not spray into eyes or face. Allow pet to dry before returning it to cage. As pet dries, keep it in a warm area to prevent it from getting chills. Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: If empty: Do not reuse container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.

FIRST AID

If swallowed
