DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Shake well before use. This product must be diluted before use. Shake or stir thoroughly before using or reusing the final diluted emulsified solution.

TO KILL FLEAS, TICKS AND LICE:

Dilute 2 fluid ounces (4 tablespoons), with one gallon of water. Dip arimal into solution, or sponge on solution, making sure hair is thoroughly wet to the skin. The area around the ears should be sponged thoroughly. Avoid contact of material with eyes and mouth of animal.

8 IN 1 14 DAYS FLEA & TICK DIP gives long lasting residual control and repellency of fleas and ticks on dogs and cats. Repeat application every two weeks or as necessary.
