DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Livestock remedy. Do not apply to humans. For external use only. Use only on show, race, work or pleasure horses. Do not use on horses intended for slaughter. Fly Repellent Gel is a ready-to-use wipe-on product designed to protect horses and ponies from biting and nuisance flies, such as stable flies, horn flies, horse flies, face flies and houseflies, as well as mosquitoes and gnats.

Remove excess dirt and dust by brushing coat. Extremely dirty horses/ponies should be shampooed, rinsed and the coat allowed to dry before application. Lift nozzle cap and squeeze bottle for easy flow of product onto a gauze pad or desired area, then rub into coat. It is especially adaptable for treating difficult areas such as the face or head. Avoid application to the animal's eyes. Apply approximately 2 ounces per animal, depending upon animal size, using a sufficient amount to thoroughly treat coat. May be applied daily or at intervals necessary to give desired protection. Reapply each time animal is washed or exposed to heavy rain. Environmental conditions, such as temperature and humidity, and cleanliness of animal's coat will affect the amount of product required to do an effective job. It may be necessary to experiment with the amount applied and the treatment interval in order to achieve optimum effectiveness.

This gel will not remove or discolor hair. Fly Repellent Gel imparts a high gloss to the coat when brushed out and leaves no embarrassing "greasy" effect to collect dust and dirt prior to showing.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

[For containers greater than 1 gallon:]

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Store in a cool, dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat and open flame.
Pesticide Disposal: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.
Container Disposal: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

[For containers 1 gallon or less:]

Storage: Store in a cool, dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat and open flame.
Disposal: Do not reuse empty container; wrap and put in trash.
