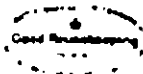

## VANISH TOILET BOWL CLEANER

### CAP INSTRUCTIONS

1. Place cap over hole with thumb on center and push down with other hand.  
2. Twist cap to the right and pull up.  
3. The cap is now open. Make the cap is on tight.

**HOW IT WORKS:** VANISH releases hard working cleaning power to make your toilet bowl sparkle again. VANISH also kills staph and most other common household bacteria. Deodorizes your bathroom air too!

### DIRECTIONS FOR HOME OR INSTITUTIONAL USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**TO DISINFECT & CLEAN:** Raise the toilet seat. Flush toilet to wet surfaces and to remove heavy soil. Pour 1/2 cup of VANISH into toilet bowl. For discoloring, thoroughly brush the surfaces with the brush. Then in the toilet bowl let stand 10 minutes then flush. Flush bowl with fresh water after use.



**TO REMOVE STUBBORN STAINS:** For hard water stains, follow directions above. Then brush stained areas again and apply more VANISH. For best results, let VANISH remain on stained areas for at least 1 hour, preferably overnight. Then brush away and flush. Repeat the procedure if necessary.

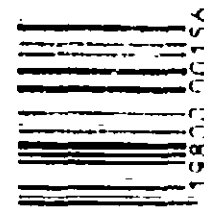


**TO DEODORIZE BATHROOM AIR:** Pour 1/2 cup of VANISH into the toilet bowl and let product bubble and foam. When bubbling stops, bathroom air is deodorized and freshened. Flush toilet.



**IMPORTANT:** Use only as directed for cleaning toilet bowls. Harmless to plumbing and septic tanks. In case of spills, sweep into dust pan and empty into toilet bowl, then flush.

**STORAGE & DISPOSAL:** Store out of the reach of children. Do not reuse container. Replace cap before discarding empty can.
