

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

FOR ORDINARY CLEANING mix 1 part to 64 parts of water (2 ounces in 1 gallon of water.) Apply freely to soiled surfaces with appropriate cleaning apparatus. Remove excess solution.

FOR DISINFECTING AND DEODORIZING. Prepare a solution of 1 part to 64 parts of water (containing 100 ppm of effective germicide, providing adequate disinfecting action) and apply freely to contaminated surfaces. Remove excess solution. Rinse treated food surfaces or equipment with potable water before reuse.

This product is non-volatile, non-corrosive to inanimate surfaces and non-flammable in use dilutions.

This product is specifically formulated for use as a multi-purpose liquid disinfectant cleaner and deodorant. Exerts quality cleaning, disinfecting and deodorizing properties in one operation. Recommended for cleaning and disinfecting of all types of floors, walls, woodwork, furniture and kitchen equipment. Bathroom fixtures such as toilet seats, exterior bowl surfaces, urinals, wash basins, showers. If used in toilet bowls, trap of residual water must be removed prior to applying use solution.
