 Terminix WP is for the combined treatment of ground and the spray and pressure treatment of timber to prevent or control rot fungi and for the surface or pressure treatment of timber to prevent or control termites or powder-post beetles that are present and to prevent reinfestation. For use only by professional pest control personnel in servicing work and not for resale.
 Mix 5 gallons of the Concentrate with 48 gallons of Mineral Spirits or #2 Fuel Oil. Apply according to procedures detailed in Terminix Treatment Manual, Key 31034 and Terminix Treating Technique for Powder-Post Beetles, Key 1-9A.
