**NOTE:** Terminix SF is for use only in servicing work and is not for resale.

This product and the treatment prescribed for it is not a proper control method for termites. It is for use only to prevent swarms of termites from beneath slabs.

Applicators must wear the following protective clothing during the application process: a light-weight protective suit or coveralls; water resistant hat; unlined, waterproof gloves; and unlined, lightweight boots. Mixers and loaders must also wear goggles or a face shield, water-proof gloves and a water proof apron.

Applicators working in enclosed areas, such as crawl spaces, must wear a respirator approved by OSHA (29 CFR 1910.134).

Terminix A-4  
EPA Registration No. 1927-12  
Your Application Dated December 8, 1983

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Revise the text of the restricted use statement to read as follows (the PD 4 document was incorrect in regard to this item): "For retail sale to and use only by Certified Applicators or persons under their direct supervision and only for those uses covered by the Certified Applicator's certification."
2. Revise the respirator recommendations to read "Applicators working in enclosed areas must wear a pesticide respirator jointly approved by the Mine Safety and Health Administration and by the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health under the provisions of 30 CFR Part 11."
3. The labeling should be brought into conformance with section 162.10 of the regulations in regard to format, headings, and required text.
4. A Statement of Practical Treatment must be added to the labeling. We suggest the following statement; however, if your toxicological data suggest otherwise, please submit a draft Statement of Practical Treatment for prior approval:

If swallowed - Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water. Induce vomiting only under medical supervision.

Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person.

- If inhaled - Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

Submit five (5) copies of your revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the amended labeling.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

If you hold a Federal registration, a supplemental registration, or a Special Local Needs registration, you may continue to produce new stocks of such products, using current labeling, until May 4, 1984. After that date, all remaining inventories of affected products will fall under the Existing Stocks provisions stated in our letter of October 28, 1983.
