

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Place baits in locations where Norway and roof rats and house mice feed, water, and/or travel. Bait placements along walls, in corners, and in concealed locations where Norway and roof rats and house mice can feed unobserved are desirable. Contaminated or spoiled baits should be replaced promptly.

Where a continuous source of infestation is present, permanent bait stations should be established and the bait replenished as needed.

Norway and Roof Rats: Place 4 to 16 ounces of bait per placement. An uninterrupted supply of bait should be maintained for at least 10 days.


House Mice: Tablespoon amounts (1/4 to 1/2 ounce) of bait should be placed at 8 to 12-foot intervals. An uninterrupted supply of bait should be maintained for at least 15 days.
