

DIRECTIONS FOR USE
HOUSEHOLD

RESISTANT AND NON-RESISTANT COCKROACHES

DUREBAN 2E insecticide mixes readily with water or oil. Dilute the required amount of DUREBAN 2E in water or in a base oil such as deodorized kerosene or No. 2 fuel oil. Mix according to the following table to obtain the desired concentration of 0.25% or 0.50% DUREBAN insecticide. Use the higher concentration (0.50%) to quickly reduce heavy cockroach infestations and the lower concentration (0.25%) on light infestations.

Amount of DUREBAN 2E to use

Amount of Spray Mixture Desired	for 0.25% spray	for 0.50% spray
1 gallon	1 1/3 ounces	2 2/3 ounces
3 gallons	4 ounces	8 ounces
5 gallons	6 ounces	12 ounces
10 gallons	12 ounces	24 ounces

Use as a spot treatment by applying as a coarse spray or with a wet brush, to areas where cockroaches normally are found. These areas include dark corners of rooms and closets, at the base of walls, in cracks in the wall, behind baseboards, behind and beneath sinks, refrigerators, stoves and cabinets, and around drain-pipes. Apply in a manner to avoid spray or mist contacting food, feedstuff and water supplies. Dishes and food handling utensils should be thoroughly washed in soap and water if they have become contaminated by the application of this product. Repeat treatment as needed.

NOTE: A period of 4 to 7 days after treatment is normally required for maximum effect on cockroaches.

LAWNS AND TURF

CHINCH BUGS AND SOD WEB WORMS

Apply DUREBAN 2E insecticide uniformly over the turf with sprayer according to the rates indicated in the accompanying table. Make the first treatment when the insects first appear and re-treat as needed. The lawn should be moist at the time of application.

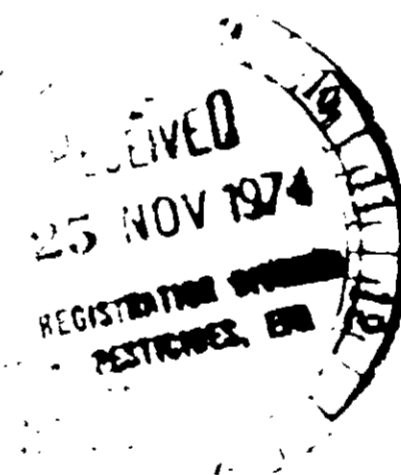
