

INSTRUCTIONS

FOR HOUSEHOLD USE DOSAGE SHOULD BE LIMITED TO 3.25 OUNCES PER AVERAGE ROOM. This material must be applied by or under the supervision of Trained Personnel.

GERMAN ROACHES: Will control all species of resistant and non-resistant roaches, it is especially good on German Roaches. Dilute 1 to 19 with water or oil and use one pint of this diluted material to every 500 square feet or 5000 cubic feet of air space.

Spray all areas frequented by roaches. Spray all cracks, crevices, around baseboards, sinks and cabinets.

FLEAS: Dilute 1 to 19 with water or oil and spray cracks, crevices, baseboards, couches, stools, on the underside of chairs, bed frames and paying special attention to coil springs, bed posts, if hollow. Treat floors and floor coverings. Treat fabrics lightly to ascertain whether damage will occur. Make spot test in closets or in out of way places. Allow fabrics to dry completely before reuse.

Thorough application is desirable. Treat mattresses on underneath side only, around seams and rolls. Dog and cat bedding may be treated on underside to kill fleas, but bedding should be ventilated 12 hours before use. Use one pint to 500 square feet.

DOG AND CAT TICKS: Kennels, sheds and other areas not infested by humans which are infested with ticks and ticks must be thoroughly treated with the diluted solution. Remove animals. Apply to cracks, doors and window frames, floors and walls. Spray the walls and floor coverings. Use 1 quart of 1 to 19 spray mixture per 100 square feet.

ANTS: Thoroughly treat ant trails and areas around door sills and window frames where the pests may enter the premises. It is frequently desirable to treat the openings around water pipes, heat ducts, electrical outlets and baseboards where ants may come out into rooms from wall spaces and partitions. Repeat treatment as often as necessary to maintain effective control. Use 1 pint of 1 to 19 spray mixture per 500 square feet.

SILVERFISH: Thoroughly treat baseboards, areas behind shelving, backcases and storage areas and any other infested cracks or hiding places. Use 1 pint of 1 to 19 spray mixture per 500 square feet.

SPIDERS: Apply as wet spray along infested baseboards and corners. In basements, treat pipes, storage localities, and other areas infested. Repeat treatment where necessary. Use 1 pint of 1 to 19 spray mixture per 500 square feet.

CARPET BEETLES: Apply to localized areas of the floor, baseboards and closet shelves and work the material into cracks and under carpets where the insects may be found. Treat under side of infested carpeting. Use 1 pint of 1 to 19 spray mixture per 500 square feet.

FLIES AND MOSQUITOES: For reducing the fly and mosquito population that may enter the dwelling, apply by brushing or, as coarse, wet spray to selected outside portions of residence such as around windows, doors and screens. Apply to walls and ceilings of porches and if outbuildings. Dilute 1 to 19 with water or oil. Use 1 pint of the diluted material per 500 square feet.

DANGER

Do Not Get In Eyes, On Skin Or Clothing. Do Not Breathe Fumes. Do Not Store Near Feed or Food Products. Do Not Allow Children And Pets To Contact Treated Areas Until Surfaces Are Dry. POISONOUS if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. In case of contact wash immediately with soap and water. Wash hands, arms and face thoroughly with soap and water before eating or smoking. Wash all contaminated clothing with soap and hot water before reuse.

ANTIDOTE: If swallowed, give a tablespoon of salt in a glass of warm water and repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Have victim lie down and keep warm and quiet. CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY. If on the skin, wash with large amounts of soap and water. If inhaled, remove the victim to fresh air. Keep warm and quiet. CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY. Atropine sulfate is an antidote, as well as 2-PAM.

DANGER

Wear a mask or respirator of a type passed by the United States Department of Agriculture for DDVP protection. Wear rubber gloves, protective clothing and goggles when handling the concentrate or preparing diluted solutions. Keep all unprotected persons out of the operational areas. Do not swallow, avoid exposure.

VOLATILE COMPOUND

Because this compound is volatile, do not use where food is present and food handling surfaces should be washed before putting back into use.

USE ONLY IN HOMES AND COMMERCIAL ESTABLISHMENTS.

Do not use in animal buildings, poultry houses or in edible product areas of food processing plants.

DANGER: Keep children and pets off treated areas until the spray has dried.

This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Keep out of any body of water. Birds feeding on treated areas may be killed. Apply this product only as specified on this label. Do not contaminate water by cleaning equipment or disposal of waste. Promptly crush empty containers and bury them in locations isolated from water.

A new development to produce a longer residual and faster kill of adult fleas, roaches, flies and ticks.

Contains a volatile chemical compound which evaporates or fumes slowly into the air. It controls insects by a new method similar to a gas. It has vaporizing action as well as direct contact-action and still provides a longer residual effect. The amount of the vaporized insecticide in the air at any one time will depend upon the air currents, humidity and temperature. Surface absorption occurs on many objects, but reevaporation continues dispersing the active ingredient.

This is a combination of organic phosphates and should be applied with care. Be sure to follow directions for use.

Avoid undue exposure to the fumes. Care should be taken not to overdo. Dilute 1 to 19 with water or oil. One pint of this diluted material is sufficient to treat 5000 cubic feet of space. Exposed food should be removed. All dishes should be covered. A low pressure sprayer should be used. A air stream for cracks and crevices from which you need a good application.
