



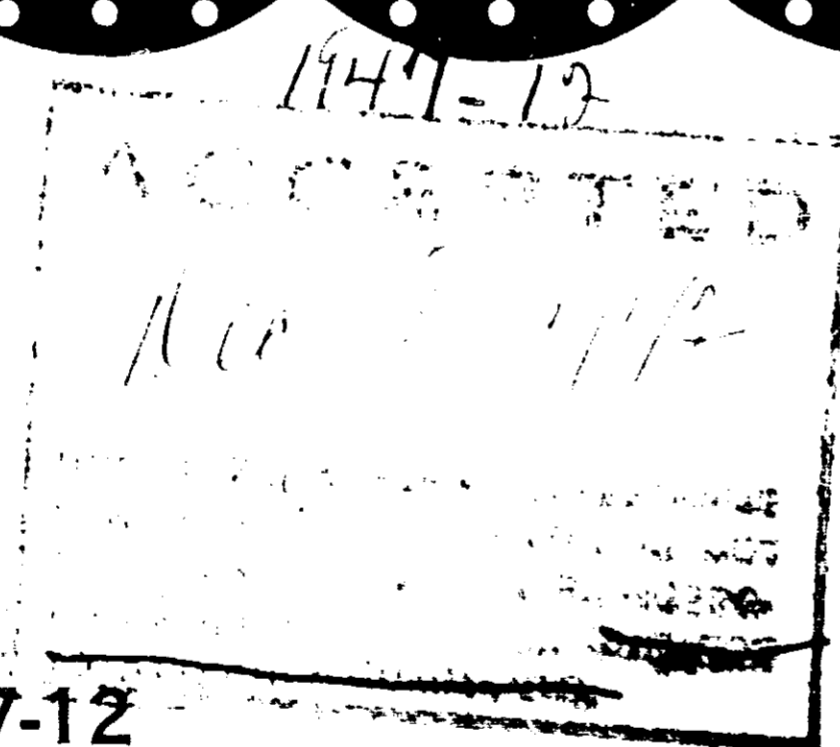

1. Scrape and prewash utensils and glasses whenever possible.
2. Wash with a good detergent or compatible cleaner (a good commercial cleaner or detergent can be recommended).
3. Rinse with clean water.
4. Sanitize in a solution of one tablespoonful to each gallon of water (200 ppm). Immerse all utensils for at least two minutes. Contact time specified by governing sanitary code.
5. Place sanitized utensils on a rack or drainboard to dry.
