



This label has been upgraded for Container disposal instructions in accordance with PR Notice 2007-4, Labeling Revisions Required by the Final Rule "Pesticide Management and Disposal - Standards for Pesticide Containers and Containment."

In accordance with the instructions of the PR notice, I provide the following statement.

"Notification of label change per PR Notice 2007-4. This notification is consistent with the guidance in PR Notice 2007-4 and the requirements of EPA's regulations at 40 CFR §§ 156.10, 156.140, 156.144, 156.146, and 156.156. Except for the formatting of currently used first aid statements, no other changes have been made to the labeling or the Confidential Statement of Formula for this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C. Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to EPA. I further understand that if the amended label is not consistent with the requirements of 40 CFR §§ 156.10, 156.140, 156.144, 156.146, and 156.156, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA."

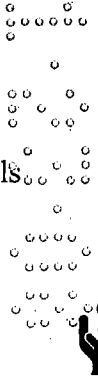

DANGER, Corrosive

Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. Material left on skin causes burns. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. This product is toxic to fish. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

- If VANCIDE TH is used in wet-end additives/industrial processing chemicals, metering pumps or other automatic dispensing equipment is required. Open pouring is prohibited.
- If VANCIDE TH is used in paint, synthetic latex systems, industrial adhesives, or fuels/oil storage tank bottom water, the vessels to which VANCIDE TH is being added must be closed and equipped with mechanical vents to the outdoors.
- Do not use this product in a way that will contact workers of other persons.
- Do not apply this product as a spray.

This active ingredient has been cleared for use as an antimicrobial agent in the manufacture of paper and paperboard. (21CFR176.179).

Preservation of Latex Paint and Acrylic Structures - To preserve water based alkaline paints and slurries in storage, add 0.5 to 0.5 pounds (0.05 to 0.15%) VANCIDE TH per 100 gallons of paint or slurry. Application should be made at the beginning of the processing activity or immediately before packaging of allowing material to stand.

Preservation of Synthetic Rubber Latex - To preserve synthetic rubber latex from attack by bacteria and/or fungi, add 0.02 to 0.05% VANCIDE TH, by weight of the latex, as early as possible in the processing stage. This level should be maintained so long as latex is in the liquid state.

Preservation of Adhesives - To preserve starch adhesives from attack by bacteria and/or fungi, add 0.01% VANCIDE TH by weight of the adhesive composition. To preserve soya flour adhesives, add 0.05% VANCIDE TH by weight of the adhesive composition. VANCIDE TH should be added after and "cooking" stage in the process and before storage or packaging.

Preservation of Cutting Oils - To prevent cutting oils from developing undesirable odors and broken emulsions due to bacterial action, add 3% VANCIDE TH to cutting oil concentrate in order that a final dilution of 1 in 20 to 1 in 75 with water will contain 400 to 1500 parts per million (ppm) of the VANCIDE TH. CONTAINER DISPOSAL - This container is "NON-REFILLABLE". Do not reuse or refill this container.

Triple rinse container promptly after emptying (see instruction). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, if available.

Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container ¼ full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times.
