

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If inhaled, remove victim to fresh air. Seek medical attention. If in eyes, immediately flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Call a physician. Preservation of Adhesives: Dry starch and synthetic latex adhesives are subject to bacterial degradation when water is added by the end user. To prevent this from occurring, add VANCIDE MZ-96 at 0.185 to 0.5% (by weight of the final composition) during the manufacture of the adhesive product. This product is cleared for use in adhesives used in food packaging (FDA 21 CFR 175.105).
