Preservation of Adhesives - To preserve starch and synthetic latex adhesive formulations (water-based) against bacterial degradation add 0.370% to 1.0% VANCIDE MZ-96 Dispersion, by weight of total composition, during manufacture of adhesive composition. This product is cleared for use in adhesives used in food packaging (FDA 175.105).

Mold Inhibitor for Latex Paint - For exterior latex paints, use 2 to 6% of VANCIDE MZ-96 Dispersion based on total weight (equal to about 20 to 60 lbs. per 100 gallons), added during the pigment-dispersion stage of manufacture.
