DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in labeling.

Petrocide 30 is an oil-soluble preservative of bacteria and fungi that cause the corrosion of oil and refined oils during transportation. Petrocide 30 should be added to the oil before transferred from the transportation container to the tank at the rate of 0.6 to 6.0 fl. oz. per 100 gallons of oil (5.0 to 50.0 ppm based on oil). Addition should be made batchwise when oil is added continuously to the suction side of the pump.

DRILLING FLUIDS: To inhibit bacterial and fungal degradation of wells, Petrocide 30 is used at concentrations of 0.06 to 0.25% based on the total wet weight of the fluid.

PETROLEUM SECONDARY RECOVERY: Petrocide 30 is used to control sulfate-reducing bacteria, slime-forming bacteria and microcellar floods, water disposal systems, and other oil-field water problems. Add Petrocide 30 at a rate of 0.6 to 3.7 fl. oz. per 1000 gal of water continuously until desired degree of control is achieved.

CUTTING FLUIDS: Petrocide 30 is used to inhibit bacterial and fungal degradation of water-based and water-soluble or emulsifiable cutting fluids in metalworking operations. It should be added to the cutting fluid at a rate of 0.6 to 3.7 fl. oz. per 1000 gal of cutting fluid.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Do not expose to extreme temperatures. Drums should be opened in well ventilated areas. Leaking drums should be disposed of in a sanitary landfill. Spills should be absorbed in a sanitary landfill.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. If you cannot dispose of this pesticide, spray mixture, or unsaleable concentrate, contact your State Pesticide Control Agency or the Hazardous Waste representative at your EPA Regional Office for guidance. Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

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
