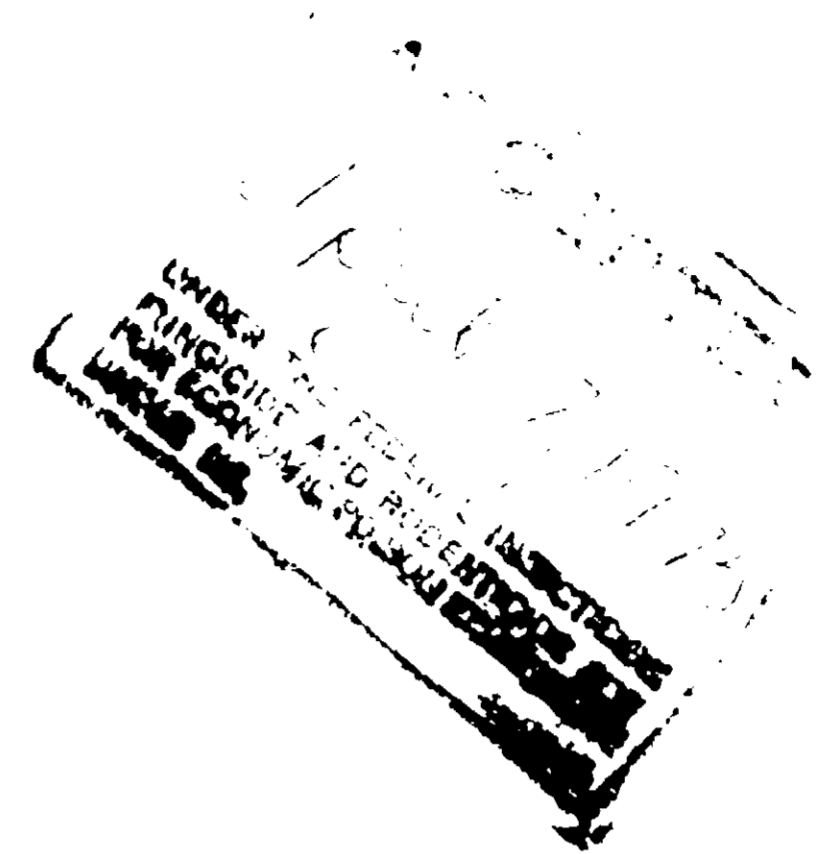

DIRECTIONS

Aim arrow on valve toward surface to be sprayed. Hold can 6 to 8 inches from surface and press valve. Apply to all exposed areas of the skin except face. Avoid contact. Do not spray a small quantity on hands and spread on face. Avoid contact of eyes and mouth. Rinse as necessary. Also apply to clothes and all other parts of the body. For insects, treat and then wash as usual. Also apply to parts of the body that perspire. Do not use on face. Safe for use on hair, skin, and nails.
