

Second and subsequent cuttings: Apply 2 to 3 quarts Coop Alfa-Cide per acre to control alfalfa weevil, leafhopper and aphids as these insects appear. First cutting and apply 2 to 3 quarts Coop Alfa-Cide per acre to the stubble to control weevil larvae and aphids. In areas where weevil appear at cutting time, remove the stubble promptly. Do not apply after full bloom. Do not apply when the weevil is small. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest. First cutting: Apply 2 to 3 quarts Coop Alfa-Cide per acre as soon as weevil damage appears in the field. Early application is desired to control alfalfa weevil, leafhopper, and aphids.
