DIRECTIONS


ON BEEF CATTLE, HOGS AND HORSES: Use at the rate of 1 quart in 25 gallons of water. Thorough wetting of the entire animal is essential for good results. Apply as a spray.

FOR CONTROL OF SHEEP TICKS ON SHEEP: Use 2-2/3 pints Lindane Dairy Barn Spray and a wetting agent in 50 gallons of water. Spray along backs and around ears, spraying against wool. Spray in fall. In some areas a repeat treatment after shearing is also advisable. About 350 pounds pressure is desirable.

YOUNG ANIMALS: Use at a rate of not more than 4-2/3 pints per 100 gallons of water. Wet entire animal for best results.

VERY YOUNG ANIMALS: Do not treat calves under 3 months of age.

DIP FOR CONTROL OF TICKS, LICE AND SARCOPTIC MANGE ON SHEEP, HOGS, AND HORSES: quarts per 75 gallons of water in dipping vat where dipping treatment is required by state law.
