**GOOD-WAY Mothproofer
 TO OPERATE**

Hold dispenser upright. Point valve opening away from face. Press button to release spray. Hold 10 to 12 inches from article being sprayed.

Spray woolen garments, such as man's suit for approximately four minutes. Be sure to thoroughly dampen entire suit especially under lapels, cuffs, collars and lining.

UPHOLSTERY—Spray only woolen or mohair and brush well before spraying. Give special attention to spraying backs and bottoms. It requires at least 5 minutes to thoroughly spray a davenport. Upon completion, entire surface must be damp to the touch.

DRAPES AND BLANKETS—Spray slowly both sides for complete coverage. Use entire contents on not more than 75 square feet.

*Mothproofs for one year when used as directed.

Articles to be treated should be clean. Complete coverage is necessary to mothproof. Spraying should be repeated after dry cleaning or laundering.

ACTIVE INGREDIENTS

Diethyl Diphenyl	
Dichloroethane	4.75%
Related Reaction Products	.25%
Petroleum Distillates	45.00%
INERT INGREDIENTS	50.00%

CAUTION: Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contamination of foodstuffs. Do not puncture container. Do not spray near open flame or store near stoves or radiators. Harmful if taken internally. May cause skin irritation. Wash hands and exposed skin areas after using. Do not spray on varnished, plastic or tile surfaces. Do not use on furs. Remove bird cages and fish bowls from room before spraying.
