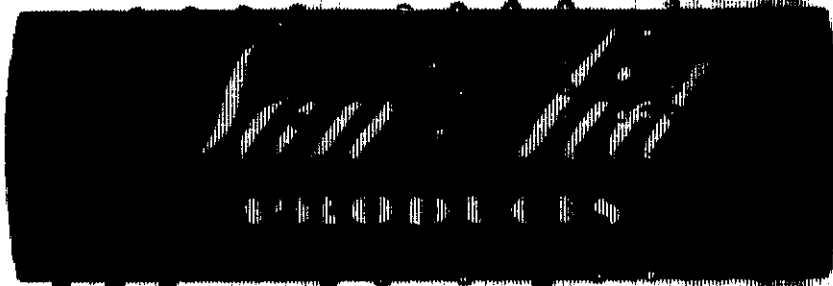

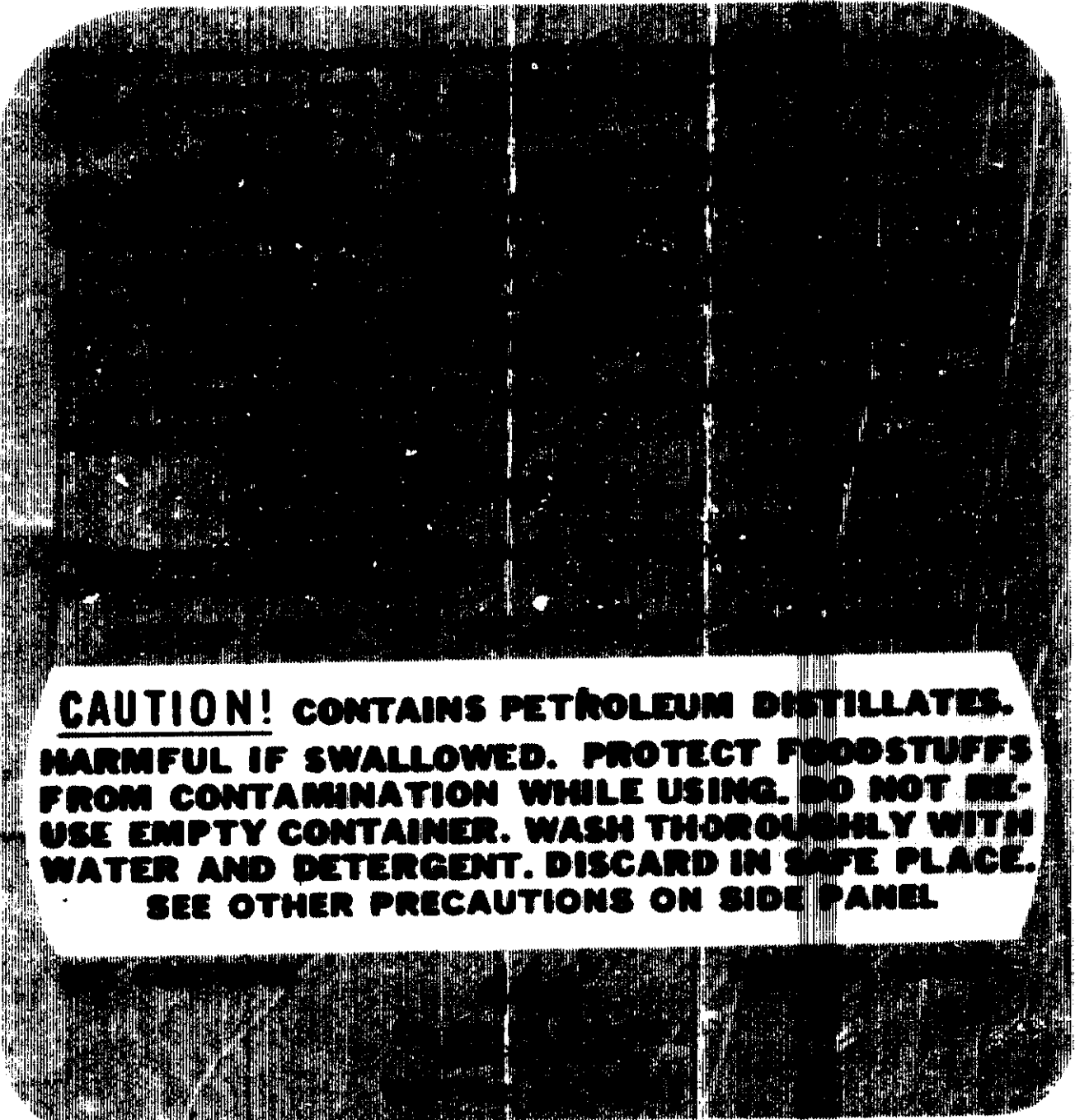

DESCRIPTION

444 Insecticide contains piperonyl butoxide, pyrethrins and a highly refined base oil carrier. It is an effective, fast-acting insecticide for control of roaches and many other injurious and annoying insects. 444 is highly useful for controlling exposed stages of stored grain and food products, industrial, institutional and household insect pests in ship holds, boxcars, mills, elevators, granaries, breweries, bottling plants, dairies, food processing plants, food handling establishments, canneries, packing houses (meat, poultry, fish,) bakeries, food markets, restaurants, stores, hotels, theatres, livestock barns, kennels, poultry houses and similar situations.

444 KILLS ON CONTACT THE EXPOSED OR ACCESSIBLE STAGES OF roaches, silverfish, spiders, crickets, ants, mites, mosquitoes, grain moths, gnats, hornets, wasps, clover mites, clothes moths, carpet beetles, fleas, ticks, bedbugs, houseflies, stableflies, deerflies, hornflies.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

CAUTION: FLAMMABLE MIXTURE

DO NOT USE OR STORE NEAR OPEN FLAME

BEFORE USING THIS PRODUCT, FOOD SHOULD BE REMOVED OR COVERED DURING TREATMENT. ALL FOOD PROCESSING SURFACES SHOULD BE COVERED DURING TREATMENT OR THOROUGHLY CLEANED BEFORE USING. APPLY ONLY WHEN PLANT IS NOT IN OPERATION. DO NOT REMAIN IN AREA AFTER TREATING.

TO KILL FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS AND CERTAIN OTHER FLYING PESTS -

Close all doors, windows and turn off air conditioning and ventilating systems, and fill the area with a light mist, directing it toward ceiling. DO NOT REMAIN IN AREA AFTER TREATING. Allow area to remain closed for 10 to 15 minutes, then ventilate and sweep up and dispose of fallen insects. Repeat treatment as necessary. The frequent spraying of breeding places, such as stagnant water, garbage and rubbish piles will also aid in controlling these pests.

STORED FOOD PRODUCTS INSECTS INCLUDING EXPOSED OR ACCESSIBLE STAGES OF

rice weevil, granary weevil, confused flour beetle, cadelle, saw-toothed grain beetle, spider beetle, Mediterranean flour moth, Angoumois grain moth, meal worm, cigarette beetle, store beetle, grain mite - Spray floors, walls and partitions in flour and feed mills, elevators, empty grain and feed bins, boxcars, food warehouses and processing plants with sufficient 444 to wet the surfaces. Pay particular attention to cracks and corners where insects may be harbored. Accumulations of waste grain and dirt should be removed before treatment. Use 444 at the rate of 1 gallon per 750 square feet of surface to be treated. Also spray sacked grain and direct a light spray to hit all exposed ends, sides and tops of stored bags. Spray unloading, handling and processing areas and apply 444 to conveying, processing and handling equipment such as inside of reel conveyors, purifier conveyors, sifters, roll housings and hoppers, pickup conveyors, etc. Spray thoroughly all areas where insects may be - under shelving, in storage cupboards, around refrigerators, back of sink and drainboard and into all cracks back of woodwork. 444 will drive the insects out into the open where they may be sprayed directly. Repeat treatment as necessary.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

ROACHES, WATERBUGS, SILVERFISH, CRICKETS, SPIDERS, CLOVER MITES - Control of these pests is obtained by spraying thoroughly all areas where insects may be hiding - under shelving, in storage cupboards, around refrigerators, back of sinks and drainboards, and in all cracks back of molding and woodwork. 444 will flush the insects out into the open where they may be sprayed directly. Repeat treatment as necessary to prevent infestations.

TO KILL ANTS - Spray liberally in cracks and crevices about the infested area, around windows and door sills and frames, on pantry shelves, behind sink and drainboard, and wherever ants are seen. Spray freely their runways and where they enter the premises. Repeat treatment when ants are seen.

CLOTHES MOTHS AND CARPET BEETLES - Take special precautions to see that all cracks in the floors and openings below the back of baseboards are thoroughly wetted with 444. Clothing to be stored should be cleaned or aired, and sprayed thoroughly, paying particular attention to seams and under pleats and folds. Chests and vaults should be sprayed thoroughly before being filled with materials being stored. Articles not stored in tight containers, closets and wardrobes where clothing is hung, should be sprayed with 444 monthly. Spray rugs on both sides, and furniture upholstery, to give them a temporary protective coating of 444. If the interior of furniture is infested, loosen upholstery sufficient to permit treatment of interior and spray padding and infested parts.

BEDBUGS INFESTING PREMISES - Apply 444 freely to bed frames and springs, forcing the spray into all cracks and joints. Spray mattress and boxed springs on both sides, particularly along seams and under tufts. Also spray back of baseboards, moldings, picture frames, loose wall paper and other places where there are cracks for the bugs to hide.

RED MITES AND BEDBUGS infesting poultry houses and henneries may be combatted by directing a heavy wet spray into all cracks and crevices, and on floors, walls, roosts, nests and coops.

TO KILL FLEAS AND TICKS INFESTING PREMISES - Spray floors, cracks and around the edges of infested rooms and areas. Fleas lurk in carpets and upholstered furniture. Spray liberally in these areas for direct contact with these pests. Remove and destroy animals' bedding and apply 444 freely to their sleeping quarters, directing the spray into all cracks and crevices. **CAUTION: DO NOT SPRAY ANIMAL PETS.**

TO PROTECT CATTLE AND HORSES FROM HORNFLEES, HOUSEFLIES, STABLEFLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS AND CERTAIN OTHER FLYING INSECTS - Spray 444 once daily using 1 to 2 ounces per head, applied as a light mist.

BLOOD-SUCKING AND BITING LICE OF CATTLE - Apply uniformly 2 ounces of 444 to an adult animal and brush into the base of the hair. **DO NOT** repeat more often than once every three weeks. A single application is usually sufficient.
