
Subject: Revised Labeling; PR Notices 2001-1 and 2001-6
Mycodex Pet Shampoo with Carbaryl
EPA Registration No. 2097-8
Your Submission Dated August 22, 2002

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided you make the following changes indicated below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. To the First Aid statements add a **NOTE TO PHYSICIAN** heading with the following: "Carbaryl is an N-methyl carbamate that inhibits cholinesterase. Atropine is an antidote. DO NOT use 2-PAM, opiates, or cholinesterase inhibiting drugs."
2. Under the Precautionary Statements for ANIMAL add the following at the beginning: "Use only on dogs, puppies, cats and kittens."
3. There are no product specific acute toxicity data in our files. The current precautionary and first aid statements indicate that the product is toxicity category III for the oral and dermal routes of exposure. Therefore revise the human precautionary statements as follows: "Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling."
4. This product only contains one active ingredient. Therefore revise the ingredient statement to read: "ACTIVE INGREDIENT:"
5. Revise "This product should not be applied by children" to read: "Do not allow children to apply this product."

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

User Safety Requirements

- Wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, shoes plus socks and household latex or rubber gloves when applying this product.
- Change clothing as soon as possible after use.
- Wash the outside of gloves before removing. As with any pesticide product, wash hands thoroughly immediately after handling and before eating, smoking or using the toilet.

Use product only outside or in a well-ventilated area. Wear household latex or rubber gloves.

This product should not be applied by children.

As a precaution, a bland ophthalmic ointment should be placed in the eyes prior to bathing to prevent possible irritation. Thoroughly soak animal with warm water taking 2-3 minutes to wet hair. Apply SHAMPOO on head and ears and lather, then repeat procedure with neck, chest, middle, and hindquarters, finishing legs last. For best effects, allow lather to remain in contact with skin for 5 minutes before rinsing. Rinse thoroughly. Repeat every 2 weeks. Do not allow to get into eyes or on scrotum. For a complete flea and tick control program consult your veterinarian.
