Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

Caution

HUMAN: Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through the skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Avoid breathing spray mist. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after using. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse.

ANIMAL: Do not use on puppies and kittens under 12 weeks of age. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, medicated, pregnant or nursing animals. Sensitivities may occur after using ANY pesticide product for pets. If signs of sensitivity occur, bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to fish. Do not add directly to water. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur.

FIRST AID

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. If person is unconscious, do not give anything by mouth and do not induce vomiting.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in cool, dry area.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container. Rinse thoroughly and wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.



DIRECTIONS FOR USE:
CATS AND DOGS

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Cover animal's eyes with hand and with a firm, fast stroke to get a proper spray mist, spray head, ears and chest until damp. With fingertips rub into face and around mouth, nose and eyes. Then spray neck, middle and hindquarters, finishing legs last. For best penetration of spray to the skin, direct spray against the natural lay of the hair. On long-haired dogs, rub your hand against the lay of the hair, spraying the ruffled hair directly behind the hand. Make sure spray thoroughly wets ticks. For improved appearance, wipe off excess with towel and comb or brush pet. Repeat grooming when dry. Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard. Apply every 14 days.

PET'S SLEEPING QUARTERS

Spray around baseboards, windows, door frames, wall cracks and local area of floors. If mosquitoes, gnats, or flies are present spray lightly into the air. Repeat as needed. The pet's bedding should be sprayed, making sure the area beneath the bedding is sprayed, too. After spray has dried, remove old bedding and replace with fresh bedding. Treat pets with one of our registered flea and tick control products before allowing them to enter treated area.
