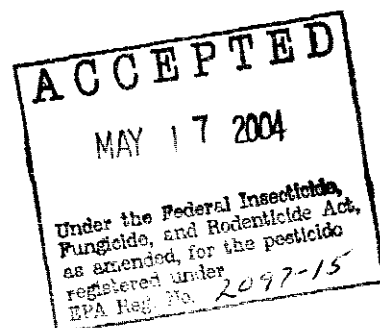

CAT AND DOGS

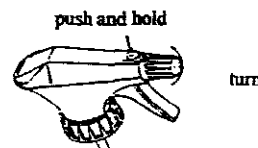
Cover animal's eyes with hand and with a firm, fast
stroke to get a proper spray mist, spray head, ears
and chest until damp. With fingertips rub into face
and around mouth, nose and eyes. Then spray neck,
middle and hindquarters, finishing legs last. For best
penetration of spray to the skin, direct spray against
the natural lay of the hair. On long-haired dogs, rub
your hand against the lay of the hair, spraying the
ruffled hair directly behind the hand. Make sure
spray thoroughly wets ticks. For improved
appearance, wipe off excess with towel and comb or
brush pet. Repeat grooming when dry. Do not use
this product in or on electrical equipment do to the
possibility of shock hazard. Apply every 14 days.

PET'S SLEEPING QUARTERS

Spray around baseboards, windows, door frames,
wall cracks and local areas of floors. If mosquitoes,
gnats, or flies are present, spray lightly into the air.
Repeat as needed. The pet's bedding should be
sprayed, making sure the area beneath the bedding is
sprayed too. After spray has dried, remove old
bedding and replace with fresh bedding. Treat pets
with one of our registered flea and tick control
products before allowing them to enter treated area.

TO OPEN: PRESS TAB IN AND HOLD DOWN
WHILE TURNING NOZZLE

TO CLOSE: TURN NOZZLE BACK UNTIL TAB
