DIRECTIONS FOR USE
ON DOGS

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Cover dog's eyes with band and with a firm fast stroke, to get a proper spray mist, spray head, ears and chest and damp. With finger tips rub into fore and around mouth, nose, and eyes. Then spray neck, middle and hind quarters. Brushing legs fast. For best penetration of spray to the skin, direct spray against the natural lay of the hair. On long haired dogs rub your hand against the lay of the hair, spraying the rolled hair directly behind the hand. Make sure spray thoroughly wets ticks. Repeat treatment as needed.

PUPPIES
 Treat same as dogs except nursing puppies. spray only along back or on your finger tips and rub in.

DOGS SLEEPING QUARTERS
 Spray around baseboards, windows, door frames, wall cracks and local area of floors. Repeat as needed. The dog's bedding should be sprayed making sure the area beneath the bedding is sprayed too. After spray has dried, remove old bedding and replace with fresh bedding. Treat dogs with one of our registered flea and tick control products before allowing them to enter treated area.

Change to Read As:

ANIMAL: Not recommended for use on cats. Avoid treatment of nursing puppies. If treatment is necessary, spray on tips of fingers and rub into coat.
