**DIRECTIONS FOR USE
ON DOGS**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Cover dog's eyes with hand and with a firm fast stroke, to get a proper spray mist, spray head, ears and chest well damp. With finger tips rub into face and around mouth, nose, and eyes. Then spray neck, middle and hind quarters, finishing legs last. For best penetration of spray to the skin, direct spray against the natural lay of the hair. On long haired dogs, rub your hand against the lay of the hair, spraying the ruffled hair directly behind the hand. Make sure spray thoroughly wets ticks. Repeat treatment as needed.

PUPPIES

Treat same as dogs except nursing puppies, spray only along back or on your finger tips and rub in.

DOG'S SLEEPING QUARTERS

Spray around headboards, windows, door frames, wall cracks and focal areas of fleas. Repeat as needed. The dog's bedding should be sprayed, making sure the area beneath the bedding is sprayed, too. After spray has dried, remove old bedding and replace with fresh bedding. Treat dogs with one of our registered flea and tick control products before allowing them to enter treated area.

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
