DIRECTIONS FOR USE

HOME LAWNS AND GOLF COURSES: To control Chiggers or Red Bugs, Sand Fleas, Ants, Chinch Bugs, Green June Beetle Grubs, Fall Armyworms, Spittle Bugs, Mole Crickets and Wireworms - use 200 lbs. of this product per acre. May be scattered evenly

over growing grass. In treating for Ants pay special attention to treating individual nests. If possible, wet down treated area after applying dust to lawns. Keep children and pets off treated areas until insecticide is washed into the soil and the grass is thoroughly dry.

CITRUS: To control Ants in citrus - mix small amount with top inch of soil around ant hill and spread additional amount around base of tree when no fruit is present on the trees.
