DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply NACO 1% Lindane Dust at any time of day suitable for dusting, using hand or power dusters.

For control of Pickle and Melon Worms on Cucumbers, Cantaloupes and Squash, apply after blossoms appear at 30 lbs. to 40 lbs. per acre, but not closer than one day of harvest. Remove excess residue by washing thoroughly. Late treatment may reduce quality of squash and melon.

For control of Overwintered, and early in the spring of the larvae of the pick worm on cucumbers and squash at 10 to 15 lbs. per acre. Allow 1 day to pass before harvest.

For control of Aphids, Thrips and Caterpillars on Collards and Cabbage apply 15 to 40 lbs. per acre. Do not apply after heads or edible parts start to form.

For control of Flea Beetles, Aphids and Potato beetles on Tomatoes apply 15 to 40 lbs. per acre. Do not apply after fruit starts to form.
