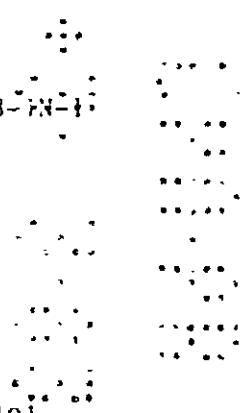

Directions For Use

For best results, apply the material when weeds are growing actively, in spring, using the recommended spreader settings.

It's also a good idea to sprinkle first. You want the weeds to be wet so the weed-killer will stick to, and be absorbed into, their leaves, killing them quickly.

After application do not water your lawn for at least 24 hours.
