

READ ENTIRE LABEL THOROUGHLY
BEFORE USE. OBSERVE CAUTIONS.
FOLLOW DIRECTIONS CAREFULLY.

Hold spray-can 15-18 inches from plant or foliage and spray in short bursts only. Closer distances or prolonged spraying may result in some foliage damage from the propellant in the can.

ABOUT WONDER-BREL

All the potential uses of Gibberellins have not yet been fully explored. However, many plants, such as those listed on this label, are known to respond to treatment with this growth stimulant.

One thorough spraying of WONDER-BREL, at the recommended time, is effective on many commonly-grown plants such as African Violets, Gloxinia, and Geraniums. However, on certain plants which require a greater concentration, the MULTIPLE SPRAY METHOD is used: the plant is sprayed several times in succession (3 or more) instead of just once, waiting until foliage and stems have dried from previous application before spraying again. Use MULTIPLE SPRAY METHOD only where indicated.

WONDER-BREL is a growth-stimulant, not a fertilizer. Because WONDER-BREL often produces more rapid and larger growth, responsive plants may require extra fertilization, preferably with a high-analysis soluble plant food such as 10-52-17 GARDEN-LIFE.

NOTE. Response to WONDER-BREL varies widely with different plants and even for the same plant under different conditions. Repeat applications MAY BE NEEDED. If excessive top-growth occurs after application, stop further treatment. Direct application to flowering buds may cause flower modification.

GENERAL DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Spray thoroughly covering all foliage and stems. Use a series of short bursts. On some plants growth response will be seen in 2 to 4 weeks. Other plants may require a longer time.

FOR MORE FLOWERS, BIGGER PLANTS. African Violets, Cyclamen, Oxalis. Spray all leaf surfaces just once at any stage of growth.

BIGGER BLOOMS. Geraniums, Hydrangea. Spray once, young plants only. Spray buds again just before color shows.

GENERAL DIRECTIONS FOR USE (Cont'd.)

BIGGER PLANTS (Increased size, height, leaf area). Ageratum, Coleus, Crassula, Forsythia, Fuschia, Gloxinia, Holly, Ivy, Peperomia, Sedum, Tradescantia, Yucca. Spray 2 or 3 times at weekly intervals, as needed.

EARLIER FLOWERING. Aster, Chrysanthemum, Daisy, Dahlia, Foxglove, Larkspur, Pansies, Petunia, Stocks. Spray 2 or 3 times at weekly intervals as needed. If no response in 10 to 14 days use MULTIPLE SPRAY METHOD.

Use MULTIPLE SPRAY METHOD
TO INCREASE SIZE OF

ROSES. For longer stems, spray established bushes when young flower stems are 3/4 to 1 inch long.

POINSETTIA. For longer stems, taller plants, spray once when plants are small. Repeat if necessary.

TREES, SHRUBS, EVERGREENS. Dwarf Azalea, Maple, Poplar, Willow Oak, Rhododendron, Ligustrum, Thuja. Spray young plants after last frost in Spring. Apply at intervals of 2 to 3 weeks. Stop treatment by August 1st to prevent possible winter injury. On larger trees and shrubs first spray only one branch to determine response.

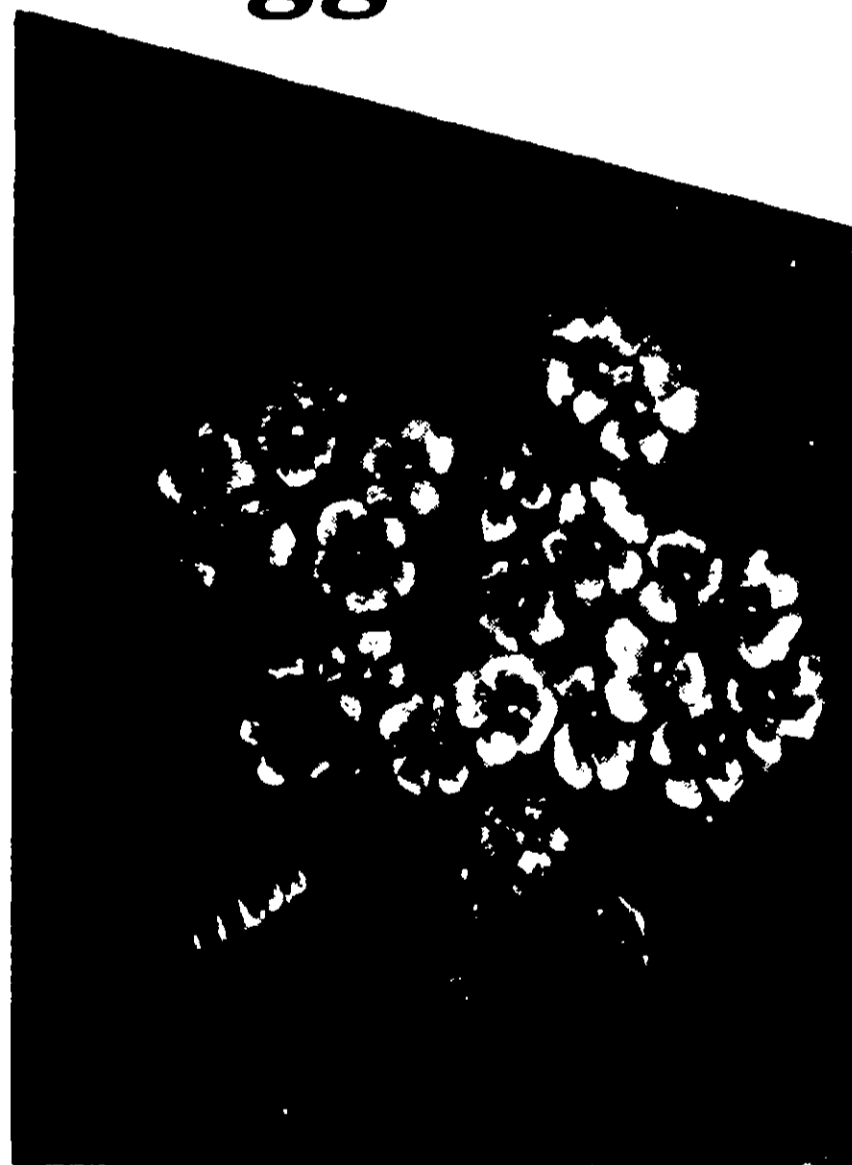
