The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Pederal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (PIFRA), is acceptable subject to the comments listed below.

- 1. Delete the second paragraph of page 2 of your label ("During commercial . . . before reusing*) since your label has no use directions for treating seeds.
- 2. We prefer that the "Storage and Disposal" statements appear after your use directions.
- 3. Add the following second paragraph to your "Storage" directions, if applicable:

Keep container tightly closed to prevent evaporation. Avoid storage at freezing temperatures. If frozen, thaw completely and stir well before using.

In paragraph #1, you may change "in a locked area" to "in an area inaccessible to children."

Please note in our March 18, 1985 letter (page 3, paragraph 7) that thiram products released for shipment after July 1, 1985, must bear the amended labeling approved in this letter.

Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

GENERAL INFORMATION

SCIENCE RABBIT AND DEER REPELLENT is a contact repellent containing 20% Thiram. It is a specially formulated, stable suspension which protects Fruit & Nut Trees, Fruit Bushes and Vines, Ornamental Trees & Shrubs, and Nursery Stock from the feeding damage caused by rabbits, deer, and meadow mice. A single application will protect treated parts for as long as 3 months, depending on weather conditions.

DIRECTIONS

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING --- KEEP FROM FREEZING. Clean application equipment immediately after using before spray dries.

WHEN TO APPLY: Apply only when surfaces of plant to be treated are dry and when conditions are favorable for drying, preferably during periods of moderate; temperature and light winds, to allow the repellent film to form and set properly. Spraying under favorable conditions is also essential to avoid excessive run-off of the diluted repellent.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE MIXING. Mix with equal parts of water. Mix only the quantity to be used and shake the diluted mixture thoroughly before application. The diluted repellent should be used immediately. Apply as a spray, dip, or brush application.

SPRAY APPLICATION: Apply as a full coverage spray on tree seedings (before planting) to ornamental plantings, or to other established nursery stock. Apply with a hand sprayer or a mechanical sprayer. Apply on Fruit & Nut Trees, Fruit Bushes and Vines, Ornamentals, and other Nursery Stock in late summer or early fall, or when rodent feeding damage is first noticed.

DIP APPLICATION: Apply to seedling Ornamental Trees or seedling Fruit & Nut Trees before planting by dipping in the solution to thoroughly wet the foliage and other parts of the seedling to be protected. Excess repellent should be permitted to run off plants without coming in contact with the roots.

SEEDLINGS AND NURSERY PLANTING STOCK SHOULD BE PERMITTED TO DRY THOROUGHLY BEFORE PLANTING OR STORING.

BRUSH APPLICATION: Apply on lower trunk of Fruit & Nut Trees or Ornamental plantings from ground level to a height of approximately 2 1/2 feet to protect plants from injury to trunk.
