PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS: May cause irritation to the eyes, nose or throat. Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Do not get in eyes, on skin or clothing. Do not breathe dust. Wear rubber or plastic gloves when handling. Avoid contamination of feed, food stuff or food utensils. Wash thoroughly after handling. **ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARD:** This product is toxic to fish. A combination fungicide and insecticide to be applied to bulbs before storing or planting. Contains THIRAM to help control storage rot and METHOXYCHLOR to control thrips. Bulbs, corms, and rhizomes, including those of Gladiolus, Hyacinth, Iris, Lily, Narcissus, and Tulip should be treated as directed.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store this product in its original, tightly closed container in a safe place away from children and domestic animals. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Do not reuse empty container. For disposal, securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash or at an approved waste disposal facility.

DIRECTIONS

PRIOR TO BULB STORAGE: Lift bulbs after foliage has ripened but before skins become brittle and break. Cut off foliage after the outside of the bulbs have dried; wipe off soils and old skins. Place bulbs in paper bag with Science GLADIOLUS AND BULB DUST. Shake gently to coat the bulbs thoroughly; or place bulbs in a box or basket and dust thoroughly with this product. Store bulbs in shallow, wire-mesh trays in a draft-free location under proper humidity and temperature conditions for the specific bulb type.

PRIOR TO PLANTING: Treat as in the foregoing. Bulbs already treated prior to storage, if properly coated, require no further treatment. Plant in properly prepared soil.

AS A DIP: For storage rot only. Mix 2 oz. in 3 quarts water or 1 lb. in 6 gallons. Place bulbs in wire basket or loosely woven bag. Agitate mixture thoroughly and dip bulbs in mix just long enough to wet them thoroughly. Bulbs may be planted while wet. If they are to be stored, spread them out to dry before storing.
