PRIOR TO BULB STORAGE: Lift bulbs after foliage has ripened but before skins become brittle and break. Cut off foliage after the outside of the bulb. ave dried; wipe off soils and old skins. Place bulbs in paper bag with GLADIOLUS AND BULB DUST. Shake gently to coat the bulbs thoroughly; or place bulbs in a box or basket and dust thoroughly with this product. Store bulbs in shallow, wire-mesh trays in a draft-free location under proper humidity and temperature conditions for the specific bulb type.

PRIOR TO PLANTING: Treat as in the foregoing. Bulbs already treated prior to storage, if properly coated, require no further treatment. Plant in properly prepared soil.

AS A DIP: For storage rot only. Mix 2 ounces in 3 quarts water or 1 pound in 6 gallons. Place bulbs in wire basket or loosely woven beg. Agitate mixture thoroughly and dip bulbs in mix just long enough to wet t m thoroughly. Bulbs may be planted while wet. It they are to be stored, spread them out to dry before storing.
