DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Durban Insecticide controls ants, chinch-bugs, sod webworms (lawn moths), cutworms, earwigs, grasshoppers, brown dog ticks infesting lawns and other ornamental and recreational turf grass areas. For best results water lawn before application to make it moist. Carefully measure area to be treated and apply proper amount of this product uniformly over this area. Mix with water according to table below and apply as a coarse spray (large droplets) using a low-pressure sprayer such as knapsack-type, or hose-end sprayer or similar equipment.
