Do not allow persons to enter or leave the room without washing their hands. Keep unproctected persons out of the room. Do not wash hands, arms, and face thoroughly with soap and warm water after eating or smoking, wash all contaminated clothing with soap and warm water, and reuse.

STATEMENTS OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed vomitus should be removed with a stomach pump or by inducing vomiting freely and abundantly by giving one dose of 10 to 20 cc. of 5% solution of peroxide of hydrogen. Does not induce vomiting if the patient has taken the second dose of syrup. If peroxide is not available induce vomiting by giving finger down method. Repeatedly vomit fluid is clear. Never give anything by mouth to a patient who is unconscious. If a medical assistant is available the correct treatment apply.

If inhaled vomitus contaminated clothing should be removed with as little delay as possible. Wash with warm water.

If eyes are contaminated wash with warm water for 15 minutes.

SYMPTOMS OF POISONING

Weakness, dizziness, headache, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, loss of consciousness. Skin may become moist and clammy.

TO PHYSICIAN
ANTIDOTE Atropine is the only specific antidote for organophosphate poisoning. It is given to counteract the anticholinergic effect and should be continued until the patient is free of all signs of poisoning. It is necessary to the treatment of the patient.

Atropine is a competitive antagonist of the action of acetylcholine at the cholinergic receptors of the autonomic nervous system. It is given in doses of 1 to 2 mg. intravenously or 2 to 4 mg. orally. The dose should be repeated every 15 to 30 minutes until the patient is free of all signs of poisoning. In serious cases of poisoning, even after the patient has been given 10 to 20 mg. of atropine, the patient should be given a large dose of atropine (up to 100 mg.) to relieve the symptoms of poisoning.
