DIRECTIONS

FOR DAIRIES, BAKERIES, PROCESSING PLANTS, RESTAURANTS and BARS: Clean equipment and utensils with a good cleaning agent (not soap), then sanitize with this product diluted 3 tablespoonfuls to 1 gallon of water and rinse. In case of milking machine equipment, sanitize and rinse before using. This product is not to be used as a preservative for foodstuffs.

FOR HOUSEHOLD USE: As a general disinfectant for walls, floors, furniture, bath tubs, bathroom surfaces, shower stalls, wash with a good cleaning agent (not soap), then sanitize with this product diluted 5 tablespoonfuls to 1 gallon of water

AS A DEODORANT in kitchens and processing plants, clean sinks, draining tables and cutting tables, with a good cleaning agent (not soap), then rinse with this product diluted 4 tablespoonfuls to 1 gallon of water. Before direct contact with food, rinse with clean water. Dilute this product with clean water. Do not use soap.

DANGER: Keep out of reach of children. Corrosive.

Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Protect eyes and skin when handling. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

FIRST AID:

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:

Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.
