As an aid in controlling horn flies on dairy cattle, after milking, dust 4 tablespoonfuls of this powder over the cows backs, necks and shoulders. This treatment will give good results for a week or more. If not washed off. Repeat application every two weeks or as necessary.

CAUTION: - Do not use the dust later than 5 hours before milking.

As an aid in controlling horn flies, on beef cattle and fleas and ticks on dogs and cats, apply thoroughly to animals and apply 1 to 2 lbs. per 1000 square feet of surface to pet quarters. Remove manure or debris before dusting. Repeat treatment within 3 to 4 weeks, if necessary.

Do not treat kittens or puppies under 4 weeks of age.

Do not treat animals under one month of age.
