

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS  
HAZARDS TO HUMANS  
AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

**DANGER:**

Highly corrosive. Causes skin and eye damage. May be fatal if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Irritating to nose and throat. Avoid breathing dust. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:**

This product is toxic to fish. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds, or public waters, unless in accordance with an NPDES permit. For guidance contact the regional office of EPA.

**PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS**

**STRONG OXIDIZING AGENT:**

- Mix or use with water. Use only in dry systems. Do not add this product to any dispersing device containing remnants of any other product. Such use may cause a violent reaction leading to fire or explosion. Contamination with moisture, organic matter or other chemicals may start a chemical reaction with generation of heat, liberation of hazardous gases, and possible generation of fire and explosion. In case of contamination or decomposition, do not reuse.
- To avoid possible leakage, store container in open air or well ventilated area. Flood with large volumes of water if necessary.

**PRACTICAL TREATMENT (FIRST AID):**

- If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Follow by giving oral cooling or Call a physician immediately.
- If on skin, brush off excess chemical and flush skin with cold water for at least 15 minutes. If irritation persists, get medical attention.
- If in eyes, flush with cold water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:**

Keep product dry in tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition isolate container if possible and flood with large amounts of water to dissolve all material before discarding. Place in trash collection or dispose in approved landfill area, or bury in a safe place.

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner  
inconsistent with its labeling.

**ONE-STEP POOL CARE**

1. Adjust pH to 7.2-7.6 using **pH Minus** (to lower pH) or **pH Plus** (to raise pH) using a reliable test kit.
2. Adjust Stabilizer (Iso-Cyanuric Acid) level to 50-100 ppm following label instructions.
3. Add 2-3 oz **Stabilized Dry Pool Chlorinator** per every 5000 gallons of pool water 2-3 times per week as required to maintain a chlorine residual of 1-2 ppm.
4. Occasionally check pH and correct **any pH** upwards or downwards.

**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

**Stabilized Dry Pool Chlorinator** dissolves quickly and completely and will not add any scale forming minerals to your pool which can result in cloudy water. Chlorine demand may increase during periods of extremely high temperatures, heavy rains or high bather loads.

**Stabilized Dry Pool Chlorinator** is also a very effective superchlorination agent! Add a double dose once a month (once every two weeks in the summer). Superchlorinate immediately if there is any trace of visible algae.
