Growing Season:

Dormant Season:

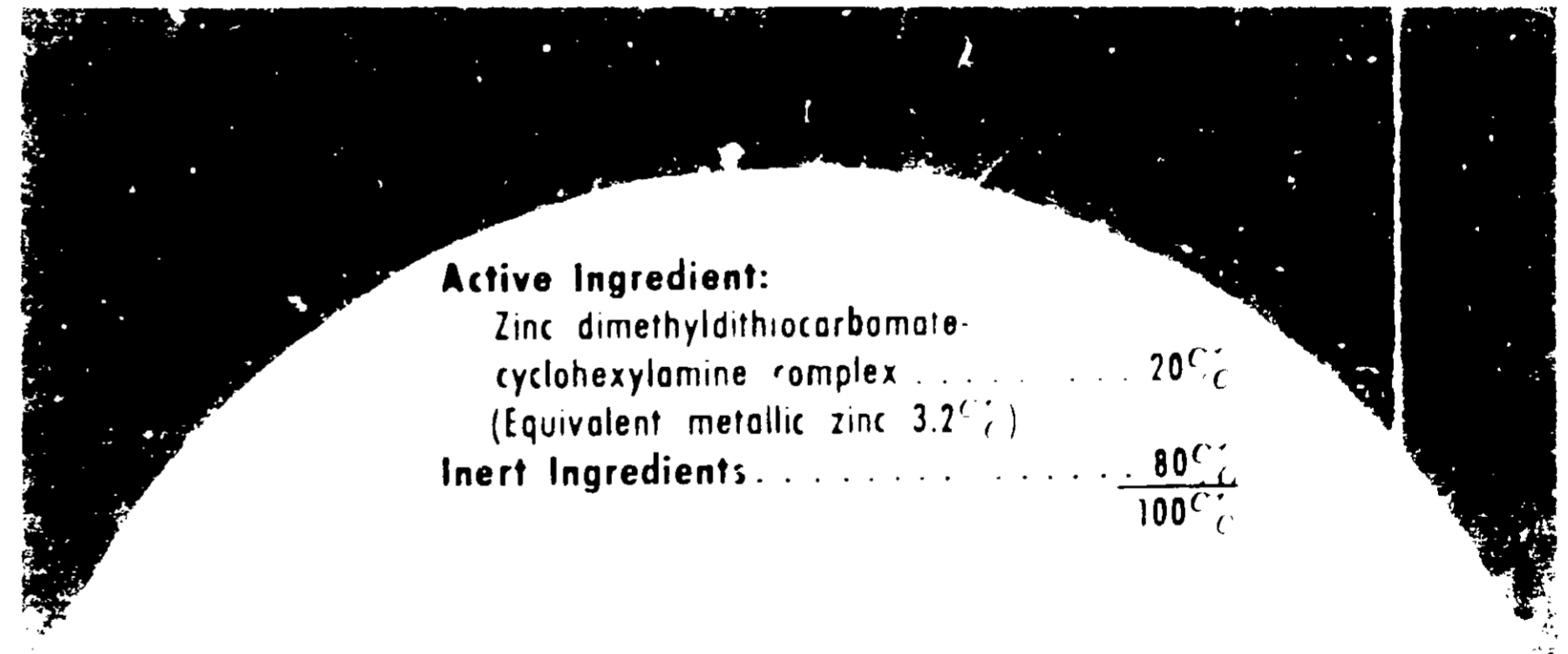

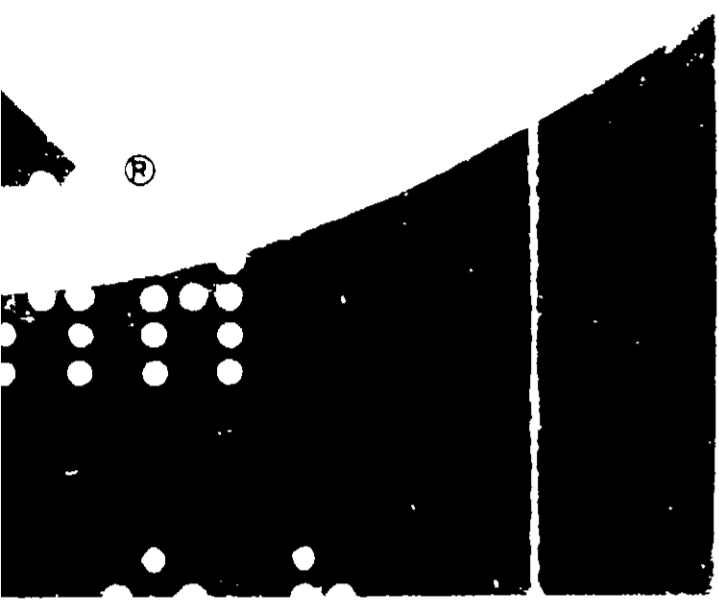

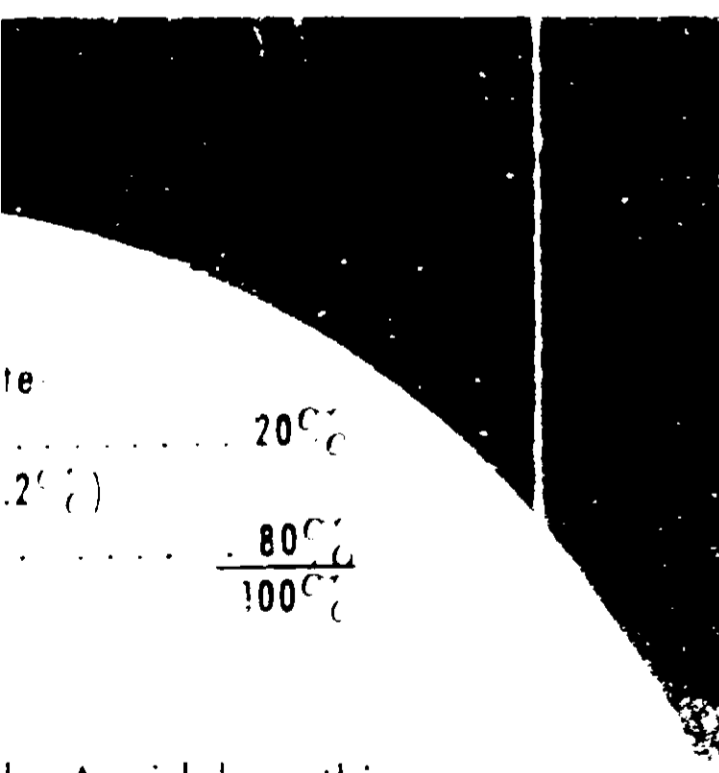

DIRECTIONS

1. Stir contents to even consistency.
2. For the **Growing Season**, use 1 gallon of Z.I.P. to 25 gallons of water or 1 pint to 3 gallons of water and apply as new growth appears.
3. For **Dormant Season** spraying, use 1 gallon of Z.I.P. to 3 gallons of water.
4. Use low pressure for spraying; 150# per square inch or less. A penetrating spray is usually not necessary.
5. Apply thoroughly to the portions of the plants that can be reached by the deer and rabbits.
6. Additional wetting agents are not necessary.
7. Protect the contents of the container from drying and freezing.
