**BRITISH TRADING**  
Do not contaminate water from an RDX/amine storage or disposal. Open storage is preferred. Periodic safety reviews are to be made. RDX/amine should be stored in a chemically compatible container. Should be disposed of at a licensed approved facility or buried in a safe place away from water supplies. Disposal of RDX is an inexpensive and appropriate method of burying it in a safe place. Contact Federal, State or local disposal authorities for approved alternative places.
