

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL — 12 point

Storage: Do not store this box under wet conditions. Handle carefully when stored at temperatures of less than 50°F to avoid breakage of soluble bag. Store away from food or feedstuffs.

Disposal: Dispose of leftover spray solution in accordance with applicable federal, state or local procedures. Dispose of empty box in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by State and local authorities.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

Fill the spray tank with 1/2 of the total amount of water to be used. With the agitator running add the required number of boxes and fill the tank with the additional quantity of water required.

APPLICATION

Use the specified dosage of DROPP in sufficient amount of water to give complete coverage of the foliage with uniform wetting of leaf surfaces. Agitate the spray mix during application.

DOSAGE

One box (5 x 1 lb. bags) of DROPP treats 25-12.5 acres (0.2-0.4 lbs. DROPP per acre). Apply in 10-25 gallons of spray per acre by ground equipment and 2-10 gallons per acre by air. Use the higher rates during periods of low temperatures.

Two applications not exceeding a total of 1 box per 5.3 acres (0.6 lbs./acre) may be necessary to defoliate such cotton.

TIME OF APPLICATION

Apply DROPP only to mature cotton plants when 70% or more of the bolls are open. Apply at least 5 days prior to anticipated picking.

NOTE: Do not use when the average 24 hour temperature is expected to be below 70°F for 2-3 days after application because defoliation may be substantially reduced.

GENERAL INFORMATION

DHOPP is a cotton defoliant to be used in removal of leaves prior to harvesting. DHOPP disperses easily in water and can be used in any ground and manual equipment designed for application of wettable powders.

It may take several days before the effect of DHOPP becomes noticeable. Adverse conditions such as low temperatures may require higher dosages and/or longer times for more complete defoliation. DHOPP inhibits regrowth after defoliation and thus reduces standing of lint during harvesting and ginning.

USE PRECAUTIONS

Do not allow spray drift to contact adjacent crops which may be injured by spray drift.

Reinfect within 24 hours after application will reduce the effectiveness of DHOPP. Use only freshly prepared sprays. Do not store spray mixture overnight. Do not feed bolls from treated cotton plants or gin back to livestock.

Do not plant small grain, sorghum, corn or root crops earlier than two weeks after application of DHOPP.

Do not plant legumes, alfalfa or leafy vegetables earlier than two months after application of DHOPP. Do not use immature crops for feed or food.
