## DISINFECTANT & SANITIZER

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

1. As a Sanitizer for dishes, glassware, utensils and equipment, wash thoroughly using a good cleaner and rinse in clear water.\* Rinse or dip in a 200 ppm solution for 2 minutes. Allow to drain and air dry.
2. As a Disinfectant or deodorant for garbage containers, dog kennels, poultry houses and other surface areas, wash thoroughly using a good cleaner and rinse with clear water.\* Mop or sponge surface with a 400 ppm solution.

### Active Ingredient:

Alkyl (C<sub>12</sub>-67%, C<sub>14</sub>-25%, C<sub>16</sub>-7%, C<sub>8</sub>, C<sub>10</sub> and C<sub>18</sub>-1%)  
dimethyl benzyl ammonium chloride ..... 10%

### Inert Ingredient:

Water ..... 90%

### DANGER:

**WARNING: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.** Causes eye or skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

### DILUTION DIRECTIONS

For a 200 parts per million (ppm) solution add and stir 1 ounce (2 table-spoonfuls) of 10% Kor-X-All Super Formula 1622 to 4 gallons of water.

For a 400 parts per million (ppm) solution add and stir 1 ounce (2 table-spoonfuls) of 10% Kor-X-All Super Formula 1622 to 2 gallons of water.

\*When soap or an anionic detergent is used for cleaning rinse with water before sanitizing or disinfecting.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.
