DIRECTIONS

All dirt and filth must be removed before attempting to do a disinfecting job.

For Disinfecting Rooms, Toilet Seats, and Waste areas around plants. Pour 1 part disinfectant into a pail. Add 100 parts of water (4 ounces disinfectant to 12 quarts water). Stir the milky solution before using. With this solution you can mop, rinse or wash.

For Disinfecting Toilet Bowls: Pour 4 ounces of the undiluted disinfectant into bowl water. Swab toilet bowl with the solution. Flush toilet and rinse mop several times.

For Scrubbing: Use one 4-oz. cup of disinfectant to a 12 quart pail of water. (Add the water to the disinfectant.) Scrub; then rinse the floor.
