

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE
GENERAL CLASSIFICATION**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

AS A SPACE SPRAY: Use 2 1/4 ounces of this product as a finely dividing floating spray or fog for each 1,000 cubic feet of space. Open all cupboards, closets and lockers. The mist should be sprayed so that it will be forced into crevices where the insects hide. An exposure for one hour will give a high degree of control, but for maximum results allow room to be closed for 4 to 6 hours. Cover all foodstuffs to avoid contamination from falling insects. Repeat as often as necessary.

ROACHES, WATER BUGS, SILVERFISH: This can be used as a coarse spray so that it will not float in the air. Direct spray to surfaces of cupboards, lockers and other places where insects hide. Spray all cracks, crevices and other hiding places, and wherever else insects hide. Spray all cracks, crevices and other hiding places, and wherever else these insects have been noticed. The specified insects hit by the spray will be killed quickly. Apply at the rate of one ounce to about six square feet of surface as often as necessary.

ANTS: For best results spray ant trails.

FOR FOOD PROCESSORS: Do not apply directly to food. If room is used for handling facilities cover or remove any food and food processing equipment during application. Do not apply when food processing is underway. After spraying in food processing plants, wash all equipment, benches, shelving, etc. where exposed food will be handled with potable water. All food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Do not remain in treated areas. This concentrate is emulsifiable solution. It is intended for use by pest control operators after dilution with water for the control of insects listed on the side panel. This concentrate is not intended for use in preparing oil base sprays, pest control operators who prefer oil base sprays, should use oil soluble insecticides.

3. Under "Precautionary Statements," add "Cover fish and remove birds before spraying."
4. File an up-to-date "Confidential Statement of Formula." A blank copy is enclosed. Minor changes may be needed in the ingredient statement if small amounts of emulsifying agents and other inert ingredients are included in this product.
