

DIRECTIONS

FOR CLEANING AND DISINFECTING: Pour 8 ounces of cleaner-disinfectant into a bucket. Then add 10 quarts of warm water. Wet floors with the solution. Allow to remain thereon for about 5 minutes. Mop up loosened dirt. Rinse freely.

FOR DISINFECTING RESTROOMS, URINALS, SINKS, SICK ROOMS, BED PANS AND GARBAGE CANS IN HOMES, HOTELS, MOTELS, SCHOOLS AND PUBLIC PLACES: Remove dirt from surface to be disinfected.
